1. RULES:

- 1.1. This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2. Participants agree to abide by the RRS and all other rules that govern this event and those of the host club. Payment of the Entry Fee acknowledges agreement and consent to the rule requirement of this NOR.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1. Skippers must be members in good standing of the New York Lakes district to be eligible to win the district championship trophy.
- 2.2. Non-class members are eligible to compete but are not eligible to win the District Championship title or applicable awards.

3. REGISTRATION AND CHECK-IN:

- 3.1. Registration may be completed using the form available at (<https://www.oswegoyachtclub.org/>).
Late registration may be completed at the Clubhouse no later than 0900 on July 18, 2026.
- 3.2. Check-in at the on-site registration desk is required, where Sailing Instructions (SI) will be provided.

4. FEES:

- 4.1. Race Registration Fee is \$125. **Early Registration fee (before July 4, 2026) is \$100**
- 4.2. Registration includes racing, as well as the Friday evening Welcome Pizza Party (6 beverage tickets and pizza), continental breakfast, build your own lunches Saturday and Sunday, and post-race snacks. A cash beer/wine bar is available. Cash grill will be available Saturday evening.

5. SCHEDULE:

- 5.1. A maximum of 6 races is planned.
- 5.2. The Regatta Schedule below provides the dates and times for regatta events. Registered participants will be notified of any schedule changes.

6. MEASUREMENT:

- 6.1. Boats and sails must conform to the Specifications in the Class Rules.
- 6.2. Each boat must carry safety equipment required by the FSSA and the US Coast Guard.

7. VENUE:

- 7.1. Events will take place at the Oswego Yacht Club Clubhouse, Wright's Landing Marina, and in the Oswego Harbor.

8. THE COURSES:

- 8.1. The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions. At a minimum, windward-leeward courses will be included.
- 8.2. The race area will be on a course in the vicinity of the Oswego Harbor, to be announced before racing.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM:

- 9.1. US Sailing Prescription Appendix V, Alternative Penalties, Rules V1 and V2 will be in effect.

10. SCORING:

- 10.1. One completed race will constitute a series.
- 10.2. Each boat's score shall be the total of her race scores, and no score shall be excluded.

11. PRIZES:

- 11.1. The New York Lakes District Championship trophy will be awarded to the highest placing member of the NY Lakes District.
- 11.2. Keeper trophies will be awarded 1st through 3rd place.

12. BERTHING/PARKING/LAUNCHING:

- 1. Boats and trailers shall be kept in the boat park area at Wright's Landing Marina east of the launch ramps. Spaces are unassigned.

13. SUPPORT BOATS:

- 13.1. A competitor shall not use support or spectator personnel or their equipment, including towing vessels, unless approved by the AO.

14. RADIO COMMUNICATION:

- 14.1. The race committee may use VHF radios to communicate with competitors while racing (CH 71).

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

- 15.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (see RRS 3 Decision to Race). The Organizing Authorities will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta and all events associated with it.
